SESSION 1~FEBRUARY 2ND CHILD-CENTERED PLAY THERAPY ESSENTIALS: AN INTRODUCTORY COURSE APT Approved Provider 12-329

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Course Description: This course offers a comprehensive introduction to the field of child-centered play therapy, an evidence-based practice for working with children. Through a combination of lectures, PowerPoint presentations, videos, and experiential activities, students will gain knowledge and develop competencies for utilizing childcentered play therapy as a therapeutic intervention for children and families. The course focuses on the philosophical foundations of child-centered play therapy, including the history of this approach, child-centered theoretical frameworks, various theoretical applications, and best practices as guided by the Association for Play Therapy. Participants will become proficient in child-centered play therapy microskills, understand the purpose and goals of this approach, explore therapeutic stages and themes, address ethical considerations, examine multicultural implications, and delve into developmental and neurological aspects. Additionally, the course will focus on treatment planning in child-centered play therapy, including setting treatment goals and assessing progress, with applications across different populations and therapeutic contexts.

3. CONCEPTUALIZE A CLIENT'S MENTAL HEALTH ISSUES AND PSYCHOSOCIAL PROBLEMS THROUGH A CHILD-CENTERED PLAY THERAPY FRAMEWORK.

4. DEMONSTRATE AN UNDERSTANDING OF THE ROLE OF THE CHILD-CENTERED PLAY THERAPIST WITHIN THE BROADER CLINICAL AND NON-CLINICAL SYSTEMS OF THE CLIENT.
